The book was released amidst an august gathering of IIMA faculty, alumni, invitees and students on Friday, March 25, 2011, at 6.00 pm at the Ravi J Matthai Auditorium, IIMA Main Campus, Ahmedadad.

The Coffee Table Book is not a history of the Institute. It gives the reader a peep into the heart and soul of this great institution. The editors have put together photographs from different stages of its development and many short, light-hearted descriptions which together give the reader a flavour of this iconic business school with all its diversity and its vibrant culture.

The book is targeted at two sets of readers. First, everyone who has been part of the IIMA community down the decades. Second, those who have heard about IIMA, are intrigued about it, and would like to know more about what makes it special and different from other business schools. This book is sure to tempt them to visit the campus and experience it first-hand.

This remarkable book is a collective effort. A team consisting of Rakesh Basant, Sunil Handa, Mathukutty Monippally, Aditi Handa, and Pranay Gupta took a year to bring it out. They got in touch with hundreds of former and current students, faculty, and staff spread all over the world. They sifted through several hundred photographs to choose the most appropriate. Some of the pieces on student life are written by those who know it intimately and from within students.
