About the Late. Sunil Mehta:

Sunil Mehta was an IIMA, PGP 1988 batch graduate. Sunil started his career with Citibank on completing his PGDM in 1988. In 1989, he started his own venture, INFAC, an industry research and information company. INFAC, which was a leading research provider in India, was later merged with CRISIL in 2000 and Sunil continued to serve as a CEO with the company till 2001. Sunil then took charge of NASSCOM's initiatives in research and international public affairs and public relations. He was a driving force in the evolving IT industry. In the 5 years spent at NASSCOM, he helped position India as a world player in IT. Sunil left us prematurely in December 2006. Sunil was passionate about innovation and entrepreneurship and the conference hall at IIMA has been dedicated in his loving memory.
