IIMA engages in discussions with AP Government

IIMA, June 29, 2010: At the instance of the Government of Andhra Pradesh (AP), the Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad (IIMA) is engaged in discussions with the Government of Andhra Pradesh for setting up an IIMA campus in Hyderabad. The Institute has suggested the AP Government to allocate 150 acre of land and provide funding to the tune of Rs. 100 crore to establish the campus. The Institute plans to begin operations by offering Executive Education Programmes and subsequently it may explore the possibility of starting academic programmes on the campus. The Institute would attempt to link the campus at Ahmedabad with the Hyderabad campus through use of technology, for seamless operations between the two campuses.
