Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC) Scholarship Programme

The PGPX Programme is now listed in the Govt. of India's 'Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation' (ITEC) Scholarship Programme under which international candidates from 141 countries with whom we have ITEC partnership would be eligible for full scholarship from the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), Govt. of India. As per the details mentioned on the ITEC website, international students who qualify and are admitted to the PGPX Programme (as per IIMA's admission criteria) would be eligible for a return air-fare, full programme fee (which includes tuition, materials and books, boarding and lodging, fees towards international immersion programme in an international university, and facilities such as computers, library, etc.,) monthly subsistence allowance, a stationery allowance and allowance for traveling in India. The interested candidate will have to first apply for the PGPX programme and get admitted. Simultaneously he/she will have to apply for the ITEC Scholarship through the Indian Embassy/Consular Office in his/her country.
