Professor Raaj Sah has joined the institute as Distinguished Fellow on February 12, 2014.

Prof. Sah is an IIMA alumnus (PGP 1975) with many and continued associations with the Institute, including with *Vikalpa* and with the Jawaja Experiment, in their formative phases.



He has held faculty positions, and has taught economics, business, and public policy at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Princeton, the University of Pennsylvania, and Yale. He is presently a professor at the University of Chicago. He holds a PhD in economics from the University of Pennsylvania.

Prof. Sah has published widely in leading scholarly journals, as well as for practitioners. His areas of research include organizations, taxation and public finance, and demographic and other societal transitions.

He has received many honors for his teaching, including three at the University of Chicago. He has held, and currently holds, board positions in business organizations and in non-profits, across continents and sectors. He has done professional work, including advisory and business-related, in over forty countries.
